

## GRUPO AEROPORTUARIO DEL PACIFICO REPORTS PASSENGER TRAFFIC DECREASE OF 9.9% FOR SEPTEMBER 2009

Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico – October 6, 2009 - Grupo Aeroportuario del Pacífico, S.A.B. de C.V. (NYSE: PAC; BMV: GAP) (“the Company” or “GAP”) announced today preliminary terminal passenger traffic figures for the month of September 2009 compared to traffic figures for September 2008.

During September 2009, **total terminal passengers** decreased 9.9% compared to the previous year; domestic passenger traffic decreased 9.7%, while international passenger traffic decreased 10.4% compared to September 2008.
